8:00 AM: Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, followed by Morning Prayer

12:00 N: The Sorrowful Mother Novena

4:40 PM: The Rosary will be said before the 5:00 PM Mass, meditating on the Sorrowful Mysteries

7:45 PM: Night prayer, followed by benediction and reposition

Please plan to set aside time next Saturday to visit the church for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and to pray for the victims and survivors of sexual abuse and their families.
