



Pentecost Vigil, Saturday, June 8: The fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost are celebrated in joyful exultation as one feast day -- one "Great Sunday." The Easter Season concludes with Pentecost, which commemorates the giving of the Holy Spirit to the apostles and the beginning of the Church. On Saturday, June 8, we will celebrate the Vigil of Pentecost at the 5:00 PM Mass. The Liturgy of the Word echoes that of the Easter Vigil in that four Old Testament Readings are proclaimed, each of which is followed by a sung responsorial psalm and prayer. It is a beautiful and fitting way to end our celebration of the Easter Season -- especially since the candidates who have been preparing to embrace our faith also will be received into the full communion of the Catholic Church.



ENVELOPE USE

With over 3300 parishioners in Sacred Heart Parish, use of envelopes is the only way we have of knowing your Mass attendance. If you are asked to be a sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation, you will need a Certificate of Eligibility. These certificates require the priest to attest that he has knowledge of your practice of your faith. So please use your envelopes. If a minimal contribution is a financial burden or if you prefer your contribution to be anonymous, please put the empty envelope in the collection basket and mark an "A" on it. This indicates that you attended Mass that week. Please note, all envelopes are recorded according to when they are received, not according to the date on the envelope.

THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM is celebrated on Sunday at Noon. If you are a parishioner and would like to schedule a Baptism, please contact the Parish Office. Prior to the baptism, parents must attend a Baptism Preparation Class which is designed to instruct the parents about the teachings of the church regarding Baptism, and to offer assistance in the spiritual preparation for their child's reception of the first of the Sacraments of the Church.

GODPARENT/SPONSOR ELIGIBILITY FORMS: In order to act as a godparent for Baptism or a Sponsor for Confirmation, one must be a Catholic in good standing. Specifically this means Mass attendance every Sunday (Exodus 20:8), striving to live the moral precepts of the Church, and if married, a valid marriage in the Catholic Church.

RCIA (RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS): Those who desire entrance into the Catholic Church are warmly welcome through the RCIA. Please contact the Pastor for more information.

THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Parishioners who are contemplating the Sacrament of Matrimony should contact the Pastor and mutually agree upon a date at least a year prior to the Wedding. The Church takes the preparation for the Sacrament of Matrimony very seriously, and requires completion of the Diocesan Marriage Preparation Program six months before the wedding. The normative time for weddings is Saturday between 10:00 AM and 1:30 PM. Weddings are not celebrated on major holidays, nor on the first weekend of June in deference to Ordination of Priests each year at that time. Either the Bride or the Groom must be a practicing member of Sacred Heart Parish in order to request a wedding date.

COMMUNION TO THE HOMEBOUND: A Priest or Deacon will visit monthly. Extraordinary Ministers visit those who wish to receive more often. Always notify us about the homebound parishioners who wish to be visited.

THE SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK is given to those who are seriously ill and in danger of death. When there is danger of death, please call the Pastor anytime, day or night.

PARISH MEMORIALS: Following the death of a relative or friend, offerings may be made to the Church in loving memory of the deceased. Offerings may specify a particular request or be placed in the Memorial Fund for parish needs.

PARISH SCHOOL: Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish School is a fully-accredited Pre-Kindergarten, Elementary and Middle school of the Diocese of Allentown. Moral development, proper study skills, and strength of character are integrated into our academic plan. Registration for all grades is ongoing.
